Bhola Nath Banstola, an indigenous Nepali shaman, will be coming to the Denver area to conduct individual healing sessions. Bhola was born in 1966 in the Bhojpur district in east Nepal. He was called by the spirits at a very young age to become a shaman and was initiated by his grandfather. Bhola holds a Master's Degree in Cultural Anthropology from Delhi University and is a graduate in Naturopathy from the Indian Board of Alternative Medicines in Calcutta. After receiving his degrees he practiced as a naturopathy and herbalist in the Kathmandu Valley. As an expert in Nepali culture and traditional healing he has conducted extensive research on shamanism within different ethnic groups and traditions in his country, as well as, in India, Tibet and Bhutan. He is the founder of the Shamanistic Research and Holistic Healing Center in Kathmandu. Bhola works closely with his wife, Genitrini Mariarosa, and they divide their time between Nepal and Italy. For six months each year they conduct tours to Nepal, Tibet and India.
